Why do we do a summer project?

We ask all students who are intending to come to L6FC to study in September 2019 to complete a short project in their chosen subjects over the summer holidays. The purpose of this is to enable you to start researching and gaining an understanding of the topics which will be covered in your course, and to show your teachers that you can organise your time and work independently. You will bring your summer projects to college in the first week of term to hand in to your teachers.

What is the summer project?

You should carry out some research into Big Data and then write a report of between 400 and 500 words about the knowledge and skills you need to develop to be a Big Data Analyst.

Your article will need to:

- Explain what Big Data is and how it is used by businesses across the world
- Explain the 4 Vs of Big Data
- · Make a list of the technical knowledge, attitudes and attributes (attitudes like positive thinking, confidence and attributes like time management, organisation, team working etc.) needed to get a job in Big Data

Your report can be in Word, PowerPoint or Publisher and needs to address the fc
