## **Guide to your talk:**

- Relationship to Jane.
- Is the reader encouraged to like or dislike your character? Explain your response using quotations from the novel to support what you say.
- Location your character appears in and its significance.
- Impact your character has on Jane's life and what she learns from the character.
- How your character reflects something about the time the novel is set – e.g. are they deeply religious? Do they believe children should be seen and not heard? If they are female, do they seem strong and intelligent or a bit stupid?
