Why do we do a summer project?

What is the summer project?

Case Study of a Political Issue

Choose a political issue, either from the recent past (over the last year) or something which is on-going. It could be, for example, an issue concerning your local area, the economy, education, health, welfare or foreign policy.

Find out about your topic, (you can use a newspaper, the internet or news programmes on the TV / radio) so that you can answer the questions below.

1) Describe your chosen political issue

2) Explain the Government / Council view

3) Explain the opposing view
4) Has any decision been taken? / What is the current situation with the issue?
Can you give me some more guidance on what is expected?
* When making your choice of topic make sure it is an issue that has been discussed at council / Parliamentary / Government level.
