Your summer project is essentially your audition for the course. As stated in your audition letter, you will be required to perform a piece on an instrument of your choice (including voice) in front of the audition panel. You're required to

1. Rehearse your piece fully for audition – it should be between 2 and 5 minutes long.
2. If you are a singer requiring a backing track / accompaniment, let us know well in advance of the audition what your backing track is (email g.nottage@lowestoftsfc.ac.uk)
3. Let us know of any other requirements you may have



Obviously, it's very important that you find a song/piece that showcases your ability as best as possible – it's better to choose something relatively simple that you can perform well than something more advanced that leads to a less polished performance!
