<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>On public transport you must wear a face covering.</li> <li><b>Outside of your classroom you will be expected to wear a face covering when inside buildings. You will need to let us know if you are exempt.</b></li> <li>Whilst on campus you are expected to keep 2 metres apart from other learners and staff.</li> <li>Go straight to your classroom.</li> <li>Sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the building.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Your break/lunch time will be within your allocated classroom.</li> <li>There will be food points available to collect food and return to your classroom.</li> <li>College will be cashless where possible.</li> <li>If you have a large gap in your timetable please go off site if you are able to or use study spaces to work. Social spaces are not available currently.</li> <li>You may use outdoor space, but keeping the 2m social distancing.</li> <li>Use the smoking and vaping shelter nearest to your classroom only and as little as possible, keeping to 2m social distancing.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please follow social distance rules when you need to see a member of our support team.</li> <li><b>Book an appointment in advance where you can. We still want to help you, we just need to do so safely.</b></li> <li>Find our support team numbers on posters around college, on Moodle, the website or email <a href="mailto:heretohelp@eastcoast.ac.uk">heretohelp@eastcoast.ac.uk</a></li> <li>Appointments would usually be just for you. A maximum of 3 people can attend your appointment. Please let us know if we need to plan for this.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Sanitise your hands on entering and leaving the classroom.</li> <li>You must bring stationery in from home and not share this with any other learners.</li> <li>Wipes will be available for computer areas.</li> <li>Follow your teacher's instructions regarding social distancing.</li> </ul>

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You will be expected to provide face coverings and maintain them yourself.</li> <li>Please throw disposable facemasks in the bins provided or keep washable versions in a plastic bag.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Please queue using 2m social distancing.</li> <li>You will not be able to use all the sinks, as some will be out of use.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>You need to keep 2m apart where you can and wear face coverings.</li> <li>You are not able to stand and talk in the corridors.</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>There is an updated Inclusion and Disciplinary Policy and you must comply fully with these rules to keep all our college community safe.</li> <li>Follow the Catch It, Bin It, Kill It instructions.</li> </ul>
